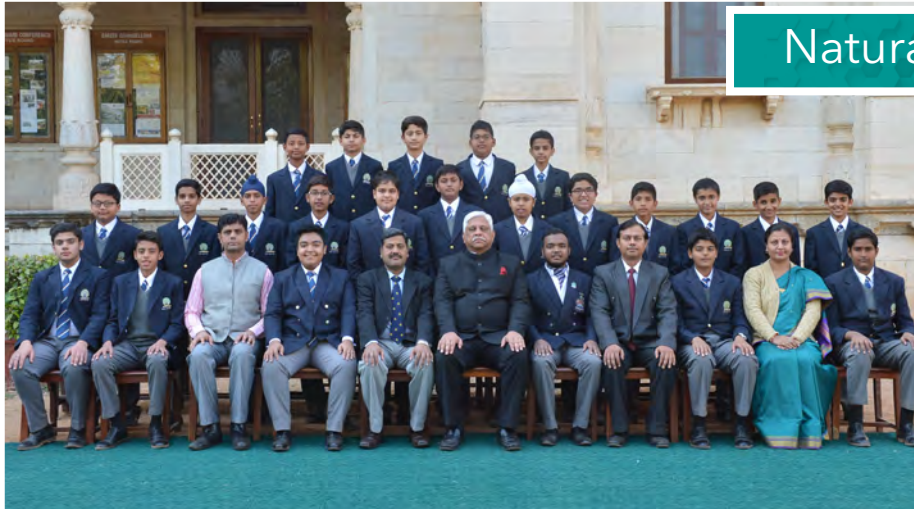

Society teachers encourage the boys to visit and explore the campus and its vicinity in different seasons, to explain to them the behavior of different species of animals in different seasons and to know about the periodic changes in plants of the campus and outside the campus. The students also study the nests and eggs of the different birds.

The Society members also regularly visit the Mayo Lake to study about migratory birds, along with the Bird Watching Society members, to know more about migratory birds, their behavior and reproduction.

In our Biology labs we conducted the dissection of frogs, non-poisonous snakes, and birds to help the boys understand the anatomy of these animals. The boys also learn how to preserve these specimens in the laboratory and in the Natural History Society section of the museum. Society members also regularly visit the Natural History Section of the College Museum to see the specimens there and learn about maintenance of the specimens.
